As the coordinator of the campout, please read and initial the following statements.

CONDITIONS OF USE

(A) Set-up and Clean-up: Each group is responsible for setting up the facility for their needs. At the conclusion of the activity, all tents and equipment must be removed, grounds must be free of trash, and all garbage must be placed in receptacles. Your group must exit the park within 10 minutes of the time stated. Failure to do so will jeopardize your groups ability to campout in the future and additional fees may be assessed. Initial_____

(B) Chaperones: There must be at least one adult chaperone per 20 minors present. Chaperones must be in attendance and actively supervising the minors at all times. Initial_____

(C) Prohibited Items: Please make sure participants are aware of and do not bring the following items. Bar-B-Ques, camp stoves, food for the animals, skates, rollerblades, bikes or skateboards, balls & frisbees, alcoholic beverages, balloons, ribbons or straws (for the safety of our animals), and pets of any kind or size. Initial_____

(D) Damaged Facilities: The applicant is responsible for replacement cost for any item that is lost, stolen or damaged during the campout time period. Such cost will be deducted from the deposit and additional costs will be billed. Initial_____

(E) Smoking: Smoking is prohibited at Fairytale Town. Initial_____

(F) Alcohol: Alcohol is prohibited at Fairytale Town campouts. Initial_____

(G) Sound: All entertainment sound levels will be gauged and controlled by Fairytale Town. The applicant must adhere to Fairytale Town's request for sound levels. Initial_____

(H) A representative of the group must be available to greet and let in guests. Unlocked gates cannot be left unattended and in-out privileges will be for emergencies only. Initial_____
