



Preparing for Your Visit

- Divide your group and assign chaperones ahead of time. These chaperones must accompany their group of students throughout the park and during workshops.
- Be sure that parents and chaperones know to meet your group in front of Fairytale Town's Express Gate, on the yellow Brick Road.

When You Arrive

- Assemble: Gather your entire group on the Yellow Brick Road in front of Fairytale Town's Express Gate.
- Count: We need 3 headcounts at the times of check in for your group, count the number of children (Ages 3-12), the number of adults (including teachers) and the number of children 2 years and under for the entire group.
- Payment: You will pay at the box office after the count is given to a staff member. Cash, checks, Mastercard and Visa accepted. No Purchase orders accepted.
- Enter: Staff will assist your group in entering through the Express gate.
- If you are visiting both Fairytale Town and the Sacramento Zoo, please have two (2) separate payments for each.
- Late comers will need to pay full admission price.

Lunches

- There are large picnic areas outside of our gates. You may have ins and outs of the park with a stamp.
- If you are interested in having lunch inside of Fairytale Town, you can reserve Sherwood Forest or the Enchanted Garden for an additional fee. Sherwood Forest reservations are taken upon availability and can accommodate approximately 50 guests.

Lost Children

- If a child in your care wanders away, please come to the admissions window for assistance and park wide announcement. Please be ready to give the name and a physical description of the child. In the event of a medical or other emergency, please come to the admissions window, the café or locate any staff person.
